underground chorale

(very quietly, sing any of these pitches, for any chord, at any octave)

Ge - as - trum for-ni - ca-tum. As - strea-us hy-gro - me-tri-cus. Ar-mil-la-ri-a lu-te-o-bu-ba - li - na. Cyt-ta-ri-a gun-i - i.

Sing chorale in time, slowly, perhaps half the tempo of the round(s), or at an unrelated (but slow) tempo. Use the chorale sparingly, leaving out any species at any time.

As one round, or four individual rounds, or 2-4 rounds sung together, or any combination/version.
