

just teach — once by note — and go right in.

voices come together here

After a while of this: add a beat (\*) at the end before starting again.

In order for the 2<sup>nd</sup> voice to also come in on the 2<sup>nd</sup> beat,  
(she will have to add 2 extra beats.)

So then the first voice adds one more beat! making it  
3, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> voice adds 4. This pushes  
it up to the last beat, and it can be held here  
a little while because when it goes forward  
again (either one of the voices) they will come  
on the unison, at which — once — stop.
