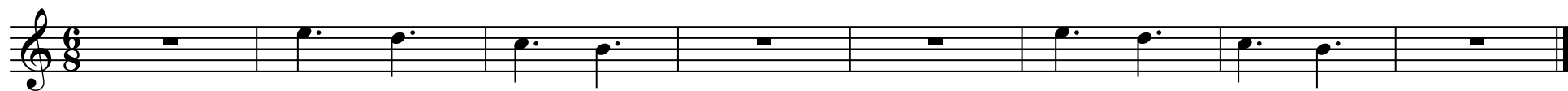


old worn-out hip! bad shoul-der! bum knee! bum knee! bad shoul-der! all sorts of worn-out pain-ful
